These sculptures of the stainless steel elements literally reflect the diverse community of Sunshine.



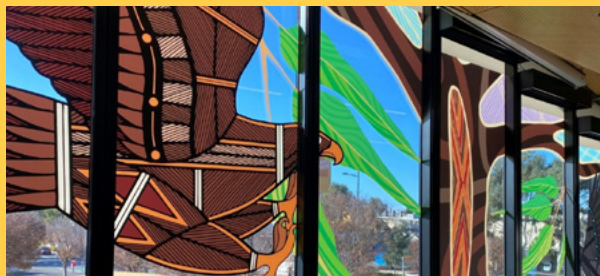

📍 Brimbank multi-deck carpark (visible from Dawson Street, Sunshine)

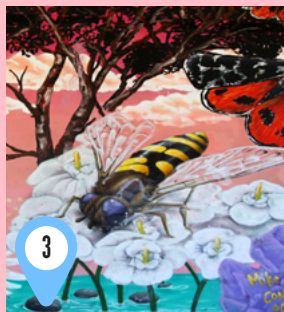
A large-scale mural celebrating the cultural diversity of Brimbank.
