Terms and Conditions

Project Overview

Resonate /'rez(ə)neɪt/ verb / produce or be filled with a deep, full, reverberating sound.

The *Resonate Youth Music Showcase* is a curated concert of young musicians, performers and artists (aged 12-25) who live, work or play in the City of Brimbank. If this sounds like you, please read these terms and conditions and complete the online application form. Selected artists will be paid to perform a live set of songs at Creative Brimbank's annual Be Bold Festival on Saturday 7th October.

Artist Fee: \$300 + 10% for individual super contribution = \$330

Performance Date: Saturday, 7th October 2023 (at Be Bold Festival 2023)

Performance Time: 1:30pm – 2:30pm

Venue: The Outdoor Stage on Errington Reserve

Considerations

Each performer needs to prepare and perform up to **three (3) songs** and will have up to **15 minutes performance time** to share with the audience.

Before you submit your application, here are some important things to note:

- Any successful applicants under 18 years old will require a consent form signed by a parent or guardian. A parent or guardian will also be required to accompany under 18 performers to the showcase.
- This is a paid opportunity for performers. You will be required to provide an ABN (Australian Business Number), or to fill out a Statement by Supplier form to receive your payment. Our Youth Arts Officer, Ash can help you with this! See their email at the end of this document.
- If you are selected, your name, image and bio will be promoted on the Be Bold Webpage, and may be used as promotional material on Creative Brimbank's social media accounts.
- Performers will be selected by a panel of young people in the Brimbank FReeZA Committee.
- Priority will be given to those living, working or studying in the City of Brimbank.
- As part of your application, you will need to submit a link, video or audio file with a sample of your original music.



Technical Specifications

Bands (e.g. drum, guitar, bass, key and/or vocal): With this setup the backline and drum kit will need to be shared with any other bands. You will also need a sound check and the backline and kit will need to stay in place until the last band plays.

Playback/Singing: The tracks will need to be original and supplied at least 1 week prior to the event. The track title should be formatted as: songtitle_actname and can be sent as a Wav or MP3 file to ashleighm@brimbank.vic.gov.au

Acoustic acts: These can either be played through DI or Mic, please let Ash know what your preference is as soon as possible using the email above.

Choirs: Choirs will need amplification and we can set up pencil condenser mics and a solo mic if needed.

Terms and Conditions

1. All participants including performers and audience members must follow standard procedures around language and conduct. Language is to be respectful at all times and not discriminatory in any way; including being sexist, transphobic, racist or homophobic. Anyone (performer or audience member) behaving or communicating offensively will be asked to leave. In the case of the performer, this may require the engagement to be cancelled and loss of the performance fee.
2. Lyrics and themes need to be appropriate for an all-ages audience.
3. Participants will retain all Intellectual Property (IP) associated with original songs. The participants will retain copyright of original material if the performance is filmed.
4. The participant agrees to permit Creative Brimbank a licence to publish reproductions of the songs (if filmed) for unlimited, international, non-commercial purposes, including on websites, social media and documentary film.
5. The participant must ensure they do not infringe third party IP.
6. The participant must adhere to Brimbank City Council and St Albans Community Centre's COVID-Safe Plans.
7. The participant will be contracted to take part in the project and will need to follow all agreements under that contract.
